ONE GOSPEL COMPILATION

JOHN 19:25-27

Yehohshua Entrusts his Mother to John:

25 Now his mother stood by the Yehohshua’s death stake as well as his mother’s sister, beside Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene. 28 When Yehohshua saw his mother and the disciple standing near her, whom he loved, he said to his mother, “Woman! Look at your son!”

27 Then he said to the disciple, “Look at your mother!”
From that hour onward that disciple took her to his own.
