WITCH'S BREW PARTY PUNCH

“Greetings! I’m Runny the witch and I want to share some recipes with you. To start, we have *Witch’s Brew Party Punch*, which is the perfect beverage for large groups of people, such as at a party or Halloween get-together. If you wish to enjoy this beverage alone, I suggest that you cut the recipe down to an eighth of the size, otherwise the soda will go flat before you can consume the entire batch. If you don’t enjoy the taste of lime or believe your guests would enjoy another flavor more, you can buy grape sherbet and juice concentrate and use blue and red food coloring to make a purple brew of this party punch. You can still use lemon-lime soda, or you can go full-on grape and use grape soda!

This beverage is more about the presentation than anything, so feel free to spice it up any way you’d like. For example, you can add gummy worms, eyeballs, or fingers. If it were up to me, I’d add some eye of newt or some bat wings, but you mortals tend not to like that pungent flavor. The most important thing is that you have a wicked good time!”

THE HISTORY

Witch's Brew Party Punch is Runny the witch's specialty. She created it after accidentally knocking a handful of potions into a bowl, and luckily, everyone enjoyed the taste! Ever since then she has tried recreating her perfect party punch. Unfortunately, while it's still good, it's always different and never quite lives up to that first time. Noticeable ingredients include: eyeballs of a large beast, wings of a bat, and earth worms.

THE RECIPE

DIRECTIONS

1. Assemble your ingredients.
2. Thaw limeade, then add can of liquid limeade concentrate to large bowl.
3. Add green food coloring until desired color is achieved.
4. Pour in entire 2-liter bottle of soda.
5. Stir until well mixed.
6. Scoop in entire carton of sherbet into mixture.
7. Stir until well mixed.
8. (If desired) transfer to decorative bowls
9. Line the rim of the bowl or decorative container with gummy worms.
10. Enjoy!
