## INTRODUCTION

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# Context

**Depression:** Everyone came across it, children and adults. First, it starts with worry and silence. **Drugs:** The reason people use drugs is to escape the reality of feeling depression and anxiety, it gives a feeling of forgetting everything as if you was dead.

**Negativity:** When you're depressed or worried, you have a tendency to have negativity. The mind is powerful. Whatever you think or do it comes out into your body and life. We have good and bad hormones in our bodies. Negativity brings out the bad chemicals into your body that makes you ill. These "bad" chemicals are good to a point in order to activate the nervous system in a stressful or an emergency situation, as long as too much is not released. The negative situations like: school, job, marriage, paying bills, or a stressful project that can lead to obsession for perfection, and time of completion can cause feelings of pressure and stress. If there are negative people that bring doubt and lack of confidence towards you, this can lead you to give up. Also, the length of effort without completion and results can cause doubt, making you unsure of yourself. The best way to deal with this is to know your capabilities and your competency. The easiest way to do avoid unnecessary stress is to refrain from things that are out of your reach. Meditate and ask yourself, "will I be able to do this without doing anything else during that time?" Other words, either do one thing at a time or do a minimum amount with the MAXIMUM time allowed. Another example is to use skills, trade or hobbies that's in your greatest strengths; most of these usually come from your childhood.

This will give you a better chance of success and happiness. If you was a child who liked to play doctor, for example, and if this was your favorite game or thing to do even after you grew older, more than likely you may want to become a medical professional. There are adults and children whom experienced certain phenomenon that indicate or reveal a certain purpose. For instance, I saved lives in a few occasions during childhood and adulthood and decided later that I wanted to become a nurse as well as a writer and artist. Have you ever experienced certain things that you ran across in similar, repeating situations? Have you ever been in a

fire and survived it many times? Have you been victimized several times and survived it, or saved a victim of crime several times with success? **Unity:** To be as one from a main source; to be intertwined from a source, one is not without the other; to be connected as a branch from a tree or being part of something that is very similar; and to be as a one.

man. Satan was put in charge to rule evil. Satan's first name was Lucifer, who at that time was an angel of splendid and beauty in Heaven before being overthrown to Earth that brought evil to it. God and his angels fought with Satan in Heaven because he wanted to rule God's throne. But if the origin of evil started with Satan, why was he in Heaven to begin with? Hell is located beneath Heaven with a great gulf fix between both. More details are in chapter two.

**First Adam:** The first man created whom God breathed His breath of life into the man's nostrils for him to become a living soul, created from the dust of the Earth.

**Second Adam:** Considered the Son of God name Jesus Christ who was created as a quickening spirit, not being directly from the dust but of spirit that entered as flesh into the womb. The first Adam was not carried by a woman as Jesus was.

**Quickening:** To be created by conception in a woman's womb in order to be implanted and develop until birth. Before this, a spirit become incarnated at the moment of conception of sperm and egg, as the way Jesus was created, and being born of the Virgin Mary.

**Formed:** To be created outside of the womb; shaped from matter; to be created and come alive after breath, soul, or electricity is entered or stored into matter. Jesus was not initially considered to be formed but created by entering a womb as a spirit, which was already formed.

# Chapter 1

## In the beginning.....

In the beginning, a supernatural being started it all, who is above and controls all things that didn't come on its own account or existence. This Great Celestial Being created everything natural on Earth and in the universe called the heavens. Children, have you ever asked your parents where did babies come from? Your parents should respond to you that babies come from their mothers' womb; which is an organ that holds and nourishes the baby until it's ready to come out. Everyone that comes to Earth has to do this as your parents and their parents had to also. This reproduction started way back to the first man called Adam and the first woman called Eve when they made babies that grew and made more babies. The Supernatural Being who is called God created these two people thousands of years ago near the Garden of Eden.

But there was a time before theirs, when these first two people were created, is when God mysteriously came into existence. Nothing created Him and nothing was before Him, God is the beginning and the end as the Alpha and Omega. God was made from matter that could self-appear that no man was able to name or identify. This unnamed matter would be too powerful to touch, view or to come near to. This is why in the bible it states that man has not seen God and lived. This self-made matter was the major part of God's being, but this was not the only matter that was in God. There are many unnamed materials in the universe that man is still unable to identify today! Even the mystery force of gravity is still being studied! In addition, if you study and look at the table of the elements in chemistry, there are new elements that are still being named, studied, and added. For instance, what is the surface of the universe consist and made of? Where does it end and begin? The bible doesn't speak any of these things and how God came into existence and the matter that He is made of. It does say that He is spirit. God wants to keep how He existed hidden. But in revelation, it states that everything will be revealed at the end of time.

A spirit is consist of a vapor and electricity along with many other chemicals that are found in our bodies, which consist of about over 98% of matter of the universe. God has a spirit that is made from the same matter and elements as our spirits are. Before He came into existence, it had to have been a dark "space" that consisted of nothing. Imagine for a moment that it was no stars, planets, galaxies, heavens, skies, sun or clouds. Then all of a sudden a self-propelling matter appeared. This matter is VERY powerful genetically-scientifically and is more than likely

of no form, odorless, and possibly consist of an unusual powerful electro-magnetic gas that can destroy all physical and possibly great parts of spiritual matter if it comes to close to it. This could be the only matter or material that does not exist in terrestrial or even most celestial creatures. God is not consist of flesh and blood, He is only consist of celestial matter along with other powerful elements that are within Him. These powerful elements are not visible to the physical eyes without them being destroyed. After this self-propelled element existed, this was God himself along with other powerful elements that He's made of. From the actions of the elements, air could have been formed in the mix of this Great Existence. Air alone is made of many elements like: nitrogen, oxygen, carbon dioxide, argon, neon, helium and some other gases; but the main ones are oxygen and nitrogen, with nitrogen being about 20%. Air is another odorless, tasteless and unseen gas that can only be felt and is another part of God.

Though, as many of the elements that are within God, they are in us also. The water and the gases that make up the air are in us as well as electrons that make up the electricity in God and us. We are made from almost all of the elements in the universe. This includes: iron, sulfur, nitrogen, electricity, water, calcium, copper, and most if not all of the other 113 plus elements that are in God as well. We and the animals are made from many complexes of elements that make one being, that one being is made of different elements that are more concentrated in more areas in the body than the other. One hair strain is made up of numerous of elements that make this one strain possible like many other parts of our body and spirit. After God came into existence, He more than likely created part of the Trinity with Jesus being first of His creations; and created the Holy Spirit. Once the Trinity was completed, they spoke to one another about the following creations. Everything God created was in spirit form before anything became physical. The elements of spirits whether these spirits were humans, animals, or other creatures were created first. Once all the needed elements were

created, each kind of spirit was of different dimensions and powers. Some of them had powers to control other spirits, there are spirits whose powers were just below God's power; and some also have magical powers. There are spirits that are also too powerful to become physical or carnal to enter a body and this is why some spirits will never become terrestrial beings and just remain celestial beings. There are spirits that can enter a physical body, but can be resurrected when it leaves the body; being resurrected means that when a spirit enters a body, it can leave a body and return to it after a certain period. The type of spirit we have can descend from heaven and into a body, which is not too powerful for this body to contain.

Some spirits may be too powerful to enter a body, but can transform into a weaker state in order for this to take place on Earth. Once our spirit enters a body, it only becomes temporary and the spirit will dwell in a terrestrial body; and once we die the spirit will dwell as a celestial being again. No flesh or bone can be where celestials dwell. Celestials have different elements with some being unknown compare to terrestrials. So, these unknown elements, besides the air, water, and electricity that are in our spirits are in God's spirit as well. However, His spirit has much more powerful elements than ours. There are so many elements that came from water or had been produced by water.

Examples of these elements and matter are: calcium, lime, mold, algae, fungus, minerals, and other elements on Earth and in the universe as well. Many of these elements come through soil and water also.

The elements that we are made of are what make up the body. But what about our feelings, the music that plays in our mind, dreams, thoughts and reasons along with daily operations of our bodies? Think about brain mass for a moment, it's flesh that is made up of nerves, chemicals, blood vessels, and other elements. All of these parts work fine until the spirit leaves the body. So, what is a spirit and what it consists to keep our bodies moving and functioning? When you try to figure out how God became who He is, take a look at us; particularly our spirits. It can be defined as: the thinking, motivating, feeling part of man, often distinguish from the body; mind and intelligence.

Now, what is in a spirit to make us do these things? Further definitions is that it also gives life, will, consciousness, thought, and connection to the spiritual world that is separate from physical matter. This complex, eternal and immortal part that's deep within us is a mystery to some people. How can something that is unseen with the naked eye that gives life, thought and will to our body that is unable to survive or thrive without it; is made of something that gives the body the ability to do what it needs to? It would take a deep meditating thought

that could answer this question. Just think for a moment, that everything in your body is connected to something in order for the other to work. Your heart doesn't beat on its own account because it belongs to a system that it needs in order for it to beat, which is the central nervous system in the cerebellum area of the brain that eventually travels to the rest of the nervous system. The brain is the main line for your physical body, but again without the spirit it's nothing.

Like other things in life that has connections, your spirit has a connection as well. In the Book of Acts 17:28, it states that we live, move and have our being in God. After He came into existence, the intellectual part of Him came along with the spiritual parts of Him as well. The unknown physical matter that caused God to become in appearance has already been discussed, but what about the matter or chemicals that caused Him to have intellect, feelings, and will? There are certain parts of the brain that controls thinking, emotions, voluntary movements, etc. by different chemicals that are located in different areas. Some of these chemicals are hormones and the others are transmitters of the brain. Chemicals in general are usually made up of different combinations of other elements and other chemicals.

As God was coming into existence, the unnamed supernatural matter possibly could have been the main source of all elements, energies, and chemicals found in us after it mixed with other new components in a new environment. Eventually, those chemicals were passed onto us as part of our development. Our spirits are very much like God's spirit as far as similarities are concerned. However, His spirit is different in other ways also. It has much more power and ability and our spirits are just the branches and offspring of His. This spirit controls our life, feelings, thinking, dreams, and is very complex. This is something that was placed inside of us that never dies, enters its carnal level during conception and leaves the body after it's been injured or ill.

Here's another mystery question: how does a spirit stays in a body without it just randomly exiting? It seems that the only time that a spirit leaves a body is when the body is no longer able to sustains itself. How can the spirit remain in a body even after it's been traumatized or stressed? Is there a connection or certain chemicals that keeps the spirit and body attached before the body is too traumatized to contain a spirit? What causes the spirit to not able to return to a traumatized body once it leaves that body? There could be an answer to these questions if you refer to something called a silver cord. This cord is invisible to the naked eye, which connects the body to its spirit.

The body immediately begins to decay once the spirit departs from it. Until this happens, the body is kept alive and warm while the spirit

resides within. Unlike toys and other man-made items, the spirit constantly keeps us alive without replacement of devices to maintain it or recharging it. Once an item's battery (life of the item) is charged or replaced, that item becomes alive again. We have a battery that is eternal compared to a battery that needs to be replaced. Nothing on Earth lasts forever, but the spirit that's within a body is eternal. What is in a spirit that is not in a body that keeps it eternal that the body lacks? In the law of the universe, things that are unseen are eternal and things that are seen are temporary.

Celestial beings have different genetic make ups than that of terrestrial beings. Some things that are unseen are in different atmospheres where earthly time and gravity doesn't exist. Also, there are different worlds in the universe where celestials reside. These different worlds inhibit different powers that operate. The part of heaven that God dwells in is more than likely where His existence appeared from. Not all spirits dwell in this part of heaven, because this area in heaven is so powerful certain spirits may not be able to withstand the atmosphere of this highest world in the universe. The Earth's atmosphere is considered one of the lower worlds. Our spirits have been through different worlds. Humans are very unique creatures. Figuring out God's existence is beyond comprehension and understanding will always be a mystery. But we all still have to believe that we didn't create ourselves. If we had this much power, we wouldn't be on Earth; we'll be in a much higher place in the universe where we wouldn't need to be taught or guided to achieve higher knowledge, healings, or plans. There is no way to be able to create oneself without having supernatural powers to begin with.

Every creature has something greater than the other, like a spider that forms a web. Can man do that, though he can make the trains and buildings? Or a bird that makes its nest that doesn't fall apart; a beaver that creates a dam; or something immobile like a plant that has the DNA to bloom flowers or produce fruit, all of which, have spirits as well that never die within them. Everything God creates have the power to create also, even an element such as water; which creates waves, which create movement, which creates a new location, which creates a new environment that creates new life. A bird creates its nest so more generations can create more nests and offspring that will serve their purpose as messengers of God: "Curse not the king, no not in thy thought; and curse not the rich in thy bedchamber: FOR A BIRD of the air shall carry the voice, and that which hath wings shall tell the matter" (Ecclesiastes 10:20). God placed a spirit in each of His creations including the waters and gave a piece of His power to each being that can create or reproduce. After His existence, He knew what He wanted

and what was in the future.

Before everything became physical and that is seen in the present was previously in spirit form. God wanted to create a physical world below Him to allow certain spirits to be blessed and given an opportunity to show what a spirit can do in a physical realm of existence as well as being able to return to the original spiritual world. Here is a verse that tells us that man came from Heaven then to Earth: “And NO man hath ascended up to Heaven, but he that CAME DOWN FROM Heaven, even the Son of man which is in Heaven”(Luke 3:13). God created everything out of love and we were placed on Earth to be able to experience love even during the stressful trials of the lower world instead of just staying in Heaven Home to show love towards each other. Though after God created Heaven as our perfect home, He wanted us to dwell in a place where everything could be seen and temporary without perfection, which is the opposite of our Heaven Home in order to strengthen and teach us for a better preparation of an eternal higher level; which will be the next life to come after the return of Jesus Christ. We all were in Heaven, our original home after God’s existence. Further understandings of this necessary temporary visit to the physical world will be discussed.

In the beginning God created the heavens, Earth, plants, animals and man. He named the first man ‘Adam’(meaning man). God created this man in His own image and likeness, which He told to His fellow creators as being the Son of God, the Holy Spirit and possible other powerful creatures; as all three are represented as the Trinity. When God said, “lets make man in our image and likeness, was He referring to creating Adam? Was Adam really the first man created? According to 1 Corinthians 15: 45-47, the first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. The first man is of the Earth, earthy and the second man is of the Lord from heaven. If the first man was really Adam who was the last Adam? Evidently, the second Adam could have represented Jesus Christ. The Earth is still turning, people are being born everyday, the last man has not yet come.

After God Created the first man, He blessed them male and female to be fruitful and multiply, Genesis 1: 26-28. But when you read Genesis 2:4-7, “these are the generations of the heavens and of the Earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord God made the Earth and the heavens.” Apparently, God created(already done) these generations when the heavens and the Earth were created the same day! Please re-read the previous sentence right before this one. Who was the first man, and the first female that was created with the man? And why would he have generations before him in the heavens and the Earth if this was suppose to be Adam? Continuing with Genesis 2: 4-7, “And every plant

of the field before it was in the Earth and herb, for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the Earth and there was NOT a MAN to till the ground. But remember, God created man in His image and likeness; so where was the first man if it was none to till the ground? Referring back to Genesis 1:27 where it says, “so God created man in his own image male and female”, which was done by the 6th day and rested on the 7th day. It continued on to say, “but there went up a mist from the Earth and watered the whole face of the ground and the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul.” God created beasts after the 7th day from the ground also and named the man Adam, which whom named the beasts of the ground. At that time, God said that it was not good for man to be alone.

Now, back to how God created both Adams along with other types of bodies created. The first man was of the Earth, earthy; which could have been the slowest type of creation compared to how the second Adam was created. The second Adam was created as a quickening spirit, which possibly was a quicker way to create man by having his spirit entering a womb for carnal development. There are other types of bodies as well that have different make-ups of matter that consist of celestial and terrestrial bodies (2nd Corinthians 15: 40). Celestial is defined as being from Heaven, heavenly, or belonging to it. These bodies are either as angels, which are immortal or as planets dwelling throughout the universe that constantly renew themselves. Terrestrial is defined as an inhabitant of Earth, earthy; being created from Earth and its contents; things that are growing on land or in the ground. Another type of body is of the water, or being arboreal. This type of body mass lives, eat and perform other activities in water only.

In Genesis 1:20, ....and God said, let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life. So, did fish actually were brought forth in creation from water like man was brought forth from the dry parts of Earth, while sea life was from the wet parts of the Earth; instead of all creatures of the Earth being from the dry parts of it? It seems to be a mystery that man was created from the ground, but sea life could have not been created from the ground and instead was created from water. The celestials whom are made of eternal matter; terrestrials whom are made of temporary matter from contents of the dry parts of Earth; and the arboreal bodies which are made up of contents from water as being the wet parts of Earth are all different forms of creation from the elements.

When God put the first man of the Earth on it, He made him to name and have dominion over the other creatures. However, in Genesis 2:20 it

states that Adam named the beasts of the dry parts of Earth or land; but didn't mentioned him naming species of the sea even though they are terrestrials of the wet parts of the Earth: "And God created great whales....which the waters brought forth abundantly...."(Gen.1:21); the whales were already named before Adam was created. What being named the fish? Was it God who seems to just bring forth all sea life from water comparing to forming man as well as beasts of the dust? Is there a special connection between man and beast since both are from the dust? Humans and animals do have the similar body parts in comparison, such as a vertebra and standing ability, along with breathing to exchange oxygen and CO2. Do fish have a special place in God? The isthmus which is a symbol shaped like a fish that represents Jesus who fed thousands of people with fish could be a divine connection to sea life. Since Jesus was one of God's major co-creators, our Savior, could have named the fish of the sea and bonded a connection somehow.

God not only put man over beast on Earth, but also He granted man higher spiritual eminence over spirits of beasts. As mentioned earlier, there are different types of spirits that possessed different powers. These powers came along with levels of authority and dominion. Of all creatures of the Earth, man has the highest eminence, and dominion over all earthly creatures; whether they are animated or in-animated. The inanimate spirits have the lowest eminence while the animated spirits have higher dominion. The higher the level, the higher ability of connecting with God is achieved along with a level of conscience, will and instinct use of intellect. Spirits that dwell in inanimate creatures and objects like rocks, plants, and water has no ability to think at will or use instinct. They totally depend on God and parts of nature's activities to survive or exist. The higher spirits use will, intellect, and instinct to survive with an ability to connect to God. Man has the highest spiritual connection to God, but what about the lower spirits like the animals? Do they have a divine connection to God? Before these questions can be answered, we need to understand the difference of how animals and humans use instinct and freewill.

Instinct is the inborn-given intellect to different species that use it to their benefit. For instance, a bird need the instinct to make a nest in order to lay eggs; while a fox creates a den for its young; or a cheetah that hunts for its prey to satisfy hunger and to feed its young. Freewill on the other hand, is an ability to make a choice for survival; accomplishing an activity. Man uses freewill more often than animals, while animals use more instincts. Both man and beast have instinct and freewill. Many people believe animals only have instinct, which is not true. Animals as

well as man have both instinct and freewill. Instinct is the autonomic natural character that is given by all animated creatures. Examples of instinct is when a creature is hungry it will find something to eat; when a part of the body needs to be scratched it uses nails instead of teeth; chewing food instead of swallowing it whole; to relief oneself; when a creature is in pain it will moan or cry; when something frightens it, it will run or panic; after a baby is born, it will develop a sucking instinct in order to be breastfed; a baby will cry when it first arrive, hungry or in pain; and if a creature is tired and sleepy it will automatically goes to sleep. Examples of freewill including the ones found in animals are: getting up to go to work; decision-making; solving a problem; go up or down a flight of stairs; drive a car or walk; caring for offspring; defend territory; fight or fleet; use of hygiene; mate selection and reproduction. Though man and animal have both instinct and freewill, both have spirits as well that go to different places after it leaves the body. The spirit of man ascends upward while animal spirits return to the ground and possibly go back to God. Animals' spirits came from Heaven as well as humans'. As it states in Genesis, God blessed man and animal to be fruitful and multiply. God is the head creator who gave all creatures powers to co-create and reproduce. The difference between co-creating and reproduction is that reproduction is when two mates create a copy of their species as offspring from their DNA. Co-creating is helping the creator to produce offspring by will. Creation by quickening is a great part of reproduction. Babies are created by reproduction as well as plants that disperses its seeds on the ground, by which, that same seed reproduced the same plant that dispersed the seed. The difference in creation compare to reproduction is that creation is when the creator used matter of different sources to create the creature or thing. Reproduction is copying from the source, by using the original matter to reproduce by developing the same offspring as the original or parent matter.

All creatures know when it's time for their reproduction. Also, they know other time of events that happen in their lives, as stated in Jeremiah 8:7: "Yea, the stork in the heavens knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the Lord"; and this is how animals may somehow have a connection to God as well as man. Adam connected to them after naming them, because God didn't want Adam to be alone. After God created Adam, He didn't want him to be alone just with animals as stated in Genesis. This is when God put the man to sleep to create a companion that can relate to him better than animals could. During his sleep, God removed one of Adam's ribs and

closed the flesh there of, to create woman; and Adam said, “therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave onto his wife and shall be as one flesh” (Gen. 2:24).

Apparently, God and Adam had known each other for awhile before woman was created and spoke with Adam about many things. Woman was not created separately like Adam as the first man was. The first woman was partially reproduced and formed out of the dust. The bible does not state exactly how the woman came about as far as her becoming a living soul by breathing the breath of life into her nostrils or stating that the Earth being a mist that covered the whole ground. Adam had to ask many mysterious questions to God after his awakening. One of those possible questions is that he asked, “what is a mother and a father?” Since he was the first man created, he had to ask God where did he come from and whom were the generations of the heavens and Earth? Why was woman created from a part of my bone? Although Adam was not made as a quickening spirit from the womb of another woman, Adam’s spirit had to come from Heaven as well; but it was entered into his body a different way than the people after Adam. The body of Adam was already fully developed after his creation and God knew Adam’s spirit and placed it in his body. Adam named his wife Eve, because it stood for the mother of all the living. God had created beasts in Genesis 1:24 and in 2:19, and the woman’s creation was mentioned in Genesis 2:22. Though this is a mystery, it shouldn’t be a total surprise; God creates and recreates very often even to this day.

After God created both Adam and Eve, why did He called both of them Adam? In Genesis 5:2 it says: God created male and female, blessed them and called their name Adam. The woman was already named Eve, who was the other Adam in this verse? Could this be other evidence that they were not the first and only people? The first generation mentioned was in Genesis 2:4, which any names weren’t mentioned; they were as hosts of the heavens and Earth. How were these generations of Adam created? Were they as quickening spirits or as living souls? In Genesis 2:2, is when God ended His initial creation and rested on the Sabbath Day and kept it holy....

## **Chapter 2**

### **He dwelled in Heaven and .....then evil was born.**

Chapter one talked about God's existence and His creations.

Everything in Heaven is perfect and without void. There is no pain, suffering, hate, or sadness. God created the heavens and its hosts out of love, which has power. Many people refuse to believe that love has power that affects their body and life. This is how God used much of His power of creation. Heaven would not stand without it, God's love is what makes Heaven perfect. When God said, "let there be" it was strictly out of love. Every being that's in Heaven has love and praises for God. God knew from the beginning to the end of how the heavens were to operate. But one day in Heaven, after God created all of His angels and other beings in Heaven is when one of these angels wanted the whole kingdom of Heaven for himself. He dwelled in Heaven and was a powerful celestial like God, but not equal in power, then evil was born. This angel's name was Lucifer who was one of the most beautiful beings God created as a great authority figure in Heaven in spiritual form. He was another proof of God's created beings before the existence of Adam.

In the Book of Ezekiel it explained how beautiful and powerful Satan was as: "Moreover the word of the LORD came to me: "Mortal, raise a lamentation over the king of Tyrus, (personification of Satan) and say to him, Thus says the Lord God: "You were the signet of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. You were in Eden, the Garden of God; every precious stone was your covering, carnelian, chrysolite, and moonstone, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquoise, and emerald; and worked in gold were your settings and your engravings. On the day that you were created they were prepared. With an anointed cherub as guardian I placed you; you were on the holy mountain of God; you walked among the stones of fire. You were blameless in your ways from the day that you were created, until iniquity was found in you....."

## **Chapter 3**

### **The Ultimate Sacrifice**

Chapter 2 discussed how evil began and the purpose of it. God knew that one day that He had to bring forth evil. Because of the attributes between God and Satan, we were redeemed by an offer of sacrifice from God. Without evil, sacrifice would be impossible, because no man can kill an immortal being. Evil caused mortality to be born, there were no mortal beings before the foundations of evil. Mortality was needed in order to sacrifice, which enabled man to sacrifice animals before Jesus' death, and enabled God to sacrifice His only begotten son Jesus once he became mortal and died on the cross. God offered this sacrifice as a price He paid for what we have to go through with Satan, by allowing tests and trials to be in our lives. Jesus was God's ultimate sacrifice.

In the early days of sacrifice, man had to offer his best sacrifice to God for his sins, which was an animal without blemish, spots, and healthy: just as Jesus was without blemish and sin, whose sacrifice was for man's sin and redemption. As mentioned, we were created in God's image and likeness including being fruitful and multiply, including offering sacrifices. God created an offspring for His sacrifice to be possible. This offspring from God was one of His first creations. This creation was the Son of God who was and still is very powerful like his Father. God's Son, just like us, was in spirit form before becoming mortal. But as mentioned, there are spirits that possess more powers than others. God's Son was created as a High Priest of the most High God, he was not an ordinary man that had a spirit that entered by conception of sperm and ovum of an earthly mother and father. God's Son was mortally created from a different method than of an ordinary mortal man's creation.....

## **Chapter 4**

# **Our Purposes: characteristics, reincarnation, and emotions**

Now that you have read how we were created and the purpose of evil, you now want to know why we were created and what is our purpose. Chapters 2 and 3 discussed how evil was born and how we were redeemed from the effects of the evil that God imposed upon mankind through Satan. Chapter 2 explained the purpose of evil, which was to test man's faith and obedience in God. Many wonder why do we have to endure evil in order to serve a purpose. Why evil has to accompany everything we do? Others may also ask, why did we have to come to Earth to serve a purpose, and just serve the purpose in Heaven forever instead? If we are chosen for a specific purpose, why do some serve a purpose through evil, like in the case of Judas, whom Jesus had chosen? Many are perplexed to why it seems in order for something good to happen, evil has to accompany the event. In order for good things to surface, we **MUST** endure or even welcome the evil event that occurred. This is part of successfully serving our purpose, by using evil as a teaching and guiding tool. Using this tool will affect your emotions and integrity along with your mental and physical attributions. The collaboration of using our eternal spirit, mind, and physical powers usually comes from an event that caused all three characteristics to come into one purpose of incarnation. But have you considered the reason for reincarnation? Or why you should or should not believe in it? Before reincarnation is discussed further, emotions and the characteristics of each type, reason for evil in accompanying our purpose, will be explained first....

## Chapter 5

# God's Biblical Promises

Chapter 4 discussed the reasons of our purposes, how to discover them, and the possible event of reincarnation. After all that you have read in chapter 4, you want to know how can you apply your purposes with understanding from the promises of God's word. Well, this chapter will give you a list of verses abstracted from the bible. This list will provide an abstracted verse that represents a certain area in your life where you may need it the most. This is why God strongly encourages us to READ the bible, because EVERY challenge or event that will be faced in life is backed by a corresponding verse of promises and covenants. Each verse listed will have the book name, chapter, and verse that relates to common problems that we face everyday.

Prayer is important to God, but just praying without reading the bible will eventually weaken faith and knowledge of God. Above all things in a man's life, God wants him to prosper and obtain WISDOM. Without wisdom, man can lose all that he worked so hard for. This is one of the most important and powerful tools that man need for growth in prosperity and survival. Prayer without wisdom is like faith without works, here's a verse that supports how important wisdom is to God after Solomon prayed for understanding:(9)"Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge they people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people? (10)And the speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing. (11) And God said unto him, because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life of thine enemies; but hast ASKED FOR THYSELF UNDERSTANDING to discern judgment; (12) Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee. (13) And I have also given thee that which thou hast not asked, both riches, and honour: so that there shall not be any among the kings like unto thee all thy days"(1 Kings 3:9-13). Also, the entire Book of Proverbs speaks how important wisdom and understanding is.

God provided man with a bible as a guidance tool for life survival and success. The biggest mistake that religious followers make is that they only listen to what their religious leader says without reading what the religion is all about. There are many preachers or ministers that say or interpret a few things that are not in the religion's bible or holy book, that they even fail to read sometimes. This book is referenced from a

Christian bible. Christian bibles have many parables that may have figurative speeches, or interpretations that may need to be studied and researched before it can be understood. The list of verses that are about to be provided may need a deeper understanding with self-research, but they will be explained in layman terms as much as possible from a Christian bible only. Again, as mentioned throughout this book, these verses that are about to be presented are not to persuade a belief or religion of any sort; it is only introducing verses that could guide a novice Christian, a person who is interested in becoming one, or a person who simply wants a deeper understanding of God. My deep sincere apology goes out to non-believers who may have already read the book this far and still remain firm in their belief system. Some verses may be offensive to even some whom that are believers of God, but ALL verses are STRICTLY from a Christian bible.

The verses will be from the words of God and Jesus that could help in every area of life from personal habits to success. Some verses may seem superficial for some people, but there are many mysteries out there that are not religiously involved or motivated, and yet it's real. The purpose of the verses that are about to be presented is to be able to understand what God expects from us, and what we should expect from Him. If you love and believe in your parents, it's the same scenario from the words they taught and promised you with expectations from both parties. Now that you have the understanding of what is about to be presented, I hope that you are ready to better yourself and the relationship of your Maker. Another word of caution, as mentioned earlier, no matter how much you pray or believe, if it's only meant for you it will happen. You may apply these verses in your life, but they will work only if something is meant for you. This is the mistake that many fail in their belief, it's ok to believe, but make sure that you have already felt the desire or other intuitive feeling in your heart of what God had initially given you. Every time you think about praying, think about Jesus of how much he prayed in Gethsemane, and God still led His son's purpose to the cross. However, there may be things that you didn't pray for and God gave it to anyway, like in the case of Solomon's prayer. The purpose of prayer is to talk to God for reassurance of the promises of His word, though prayers may not be answered frequently. Likewise, you may request to others whom may not answer, because they either weren't ready to help you, or just wasn't able to do so at an inappropriate time. While praying you should recite God the promise that you're praying about. So here are the verses of God's expectations, promises, and covenants:

## VERSES OF GOD'S PROMISES:

**WHEN IN DEBT:** "...and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow...(13)And the Lord shall make thee the head, and not the tail..."

(Deut. 12-13) ..."for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth..." (Deut. 8:18).

**PROMISE OF HEALING:** "And the Lord will take away from thee all sickness..."(Deut. 7:15).

**TO KNOW THE POWER OF LOVE:** "...He that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes"(1 John 2:11).

**TO LEARN FORGIVENESS:** "...If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and IF he repent, forgive him" (Luke 17:3).

**WHEN DEPRESSED:** "The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivered them out of all their troubles"...

(Psalm 34:17). "...Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry..."(Nehemiah 8:10).

**HAVING ANXIETY:** "Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself..."(Matthew 6:34).

**ENCOURAGEMENT:** "Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee"(Deut. 31:6).

**FOR GUIDANCE and FINDING A PURPOSE:** "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end"..... "Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee....and ordained thee a prophet unto the nations"(Jeremiah 29:11 & 1:5).

**LESSON ON PRAYER:** "And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses" (Mark 11:25).

**POWER OF WORDS:** "For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned" (Matthew 12:37). "...he shall have whatsoever he saith" (Mark 11:23).

**POWER TO CAST DEMONS:** "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the Enemy; and nothing shall by any means hurt you"(Luke 10:19).

**WHEN IN TROUBLE:** (2)"When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when

thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned...(3)For I am the Lord thy God...(Isaiah 43:2-3).

**STRENGTH and MOTIVATION** :“I can do all things through Christ which strengthen me”(Philippians 4:13).

**SUCCESS by putting GOD FIRST:** (5)“...lean not unto thine own understanding.(6) In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths” (Proverbs 3:5-6).

**TO HAVE COMPASSION:** (8)“Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: (9)Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing....that ye should inherit a blessing”(1 Peter 3:8-9).

**WHEN LONGING for the RIGHT MATE:** “And the Lord God said, it is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him”(Genesis 2:18).

**TO REQUEST anything YOU NEED:** “...My God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus”(Philippians 4:19).

**TO BE TREATED the way you WANT TO BE TREATED:**

“Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets”(Matthew 7:12).

Other words, if you treat someone negatively, expect the same in return.

If you want love and respect, you must give it for it to be returned to you.

Though we should not return the evil that was done to us, Jesus is just saying that if you treat someone disrespectful in anyway, don't cry wolf when someone has done the same to you. As Jesus stated, this is the law, which is the law of the universe of what we call Murphy's Law.

## OVERVIEW OF THE VERSES

**WHEN YOU ARE IN DEBT:** Have you ever wondered that even after you've paid your tithe, why God still hasn't blessed you? What have you done to not deserve the blessing? If you're barely able to afford to feed your family, not keeping a roof over their head by attempting to pay a tithe, you are practicing against God's principles, here is a verse to support this fact: "But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel"(1 Timothy 5:8); and:(13)"But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:(14)And thou shalt be blessed; FOR THEY CANNOT recompense thee..."(Luke 14:12-14). Being in debt and suffering from other issues is considered a curse, because you have disobeyed God's law in your issue. This is why **READING** the bible is important. Many are in debt also because, it could be other habits of how money is spent unwisely. Here are several verses on money management:

**For budgeting:** Leviticus 9:13 and Deut. 25:13-15.

**For fair negotiations:** Proverbs 22:16.

**Give:** Luke 6:38, Acts 20:35, and Matthew 6:3-4

**Lend honestly:** Luke 6:35 and Matthew 5:42

**Saving money:** 1 Corinthians 16:2

**Don't overwork:** Psalms 127:2

**WHEN YOU ARE SICK:** we get an illness, because it was either something that we done or something that was out of our control. All you can do is pray and believe by: telling God that you believe that it can be done through Your promise of Your word. Either use the verse listed above or use another one on healing, by reciting to God reminding Him that this is what You said. You **MUST** read the entire verse while in prayer with all of your soul and strength to Him! Prayers are answered on different time lengths. If the healing prayer wasn't answered, do not despair in anger; for some reason, it was meant for you to be this way to allow others to appreciate their well-being.

**POWER OF LOVE:** many don't realize how powerful love can be. Hate brings illness to your body, and it's not good for the soul either. So, if you thinking that you have an unanswered prayer over your illness or other issue, consider in asking God why. Sooner or later, God will guide or reveal to you somehow of what you could be doing wrong. Here is a verse that proves the level of your love or hate towards another can indeed

effect your body: “A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones”(Proverbs 14:30); and: “A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones”(Proverbs 17:22). **BE ABLE TO FORGIVE:** true love doesn't operate or exist without being able to forgive. We all had someone that done something bad to us, that sometimes are beyond our imagination, and letting it go can be difficult, but forgiveness should be done. However, there is an exception to this rule if the offender shows no remorse or offered repentance to you: as if he/she was glad that this offense was done to you. As stated in Luke 17:3, the keywords are 'if he repents', then you should forgive that person. Otherwise, rebuke the person, which is the same as: harsh criticizing, or to convey one's disapproval of something. Likewise, when we do something against God and not asking for forgiveness can be dangerous to you! He will surely have His vengeance upon you that you wished never had happened! So, if a person doesn't offer repentance to you, rebuke him/her, let it go, stay away, and put it in God's hands. As He reminds us, that vengeance is His, and by taking matters in your hands is a dangerous tactic that leads into trouble.

**WHEN HAVING DEPRESSION OR ANXIETY:** don't despair just because something didn't happened the way you thought it would. God knows about everything you suppose to do, and what you suppose to have that will fit your purpose. If something went wrong, share it, don't withhold it. Read James 5:16 in regards to sharing your faults to others, it worked for me!

**ENCOURAGEMENT:** the greatest way to find encouragement is to share problems with a good, trusted friend or family member. If you hold every problem inside of you, how can you get encouragement? No one knows your problem, and if the problem is unknown to them, how can they give you the wisdom and courage to solve it? Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-10.

**FOR GUIDANCE OF FINDING A PURPOSE:** finding your predestined purpose can be one of the most difficult tasks of your life. Whether you pray for it or not, your purpose will be served. Please read the Book of Jonah, it's a rather small book in the bible. This book is an example of how when a person tries to go into a different direction, other than what their heart tells them(God's speech), their purpose will be served one way or the other . As mentioned in chapters 3 & 4, Jesus tried to avoid going to the cross by prayer, and God giving you the right spirit and time to serve His purpose will be for Him.

**PRAYER AND THE POWER OF WORDS:** when in prayer remember to thank God for everything you have, those who need forgiveness, and those who need prayer before praying for your needs. Just praying for yourself is considered a weak prayer to God. .... “pray for one another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much”(James 5:16).

God gave us power through our words, our words are like living beings that controls us. “Death and life are in the power of the tongue...”(Proverbs 18:21). Just as Jesus spoke of the power given to cast out demons in Luke 10:19.

**WHEN TROUBLES COME:** troubles come from mistakes we made, or they come from something that was out of our control. “All things come alike to all: there is one event to the righteous, and to the wicked; to the good and to the clean, and to the unclean...”(Eccl. 9:2). Many times, God allows trouble to test our faith and strength on Earth, just as we were tested in Heaven before Satan’s fall. By the time God returns for us, we will surely be ready to leave this Earth of trials from Satan’s wrath against us, and will more than likely be slow of being deceived again.

**TO ACHIEVE STRENGTH AND MOTIVATION:** the best way to get strength and motivation to carry on, is to be with others you know who will provide that to you. “Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth: a stranger, and not thine own lips”(Proverbs 27:2). Because if another sees that you can do this, this is telling you that you have more than you thought, which renders success. People rarely think that they have the power to bless another by using positive words, just as we bless the Lord with praises in His name. Read Psalms 135:19-21 and Luke 6:28.

**TO HAVE COMPASSION:** if you want compassion, you must return it to someone else who needs it. You may feel that some may not deserve compassion, and others may feel the same way about you. We all make mistakes that could be either be caused by mental or physical weaknesses that should be overlooked. Even if you are a highly intelligent person who rarely makes mistakes, you still would like compassion from someone if you make a mistake eventually. No matter how many or how little mistakes you’ve made, you made them, that’s the bottom line. All you need is one small or big mistake to change your or another’s life. You may not see instant results after offering compassion, but eventually from Murphy’s Law it will be returned! So, treat another as the way you would like to be treated.

**TO HAVE A COMPANION:** there is someone for everybody. However, companionship may come sooner or later to some. If in doubt, remember Philippians 4:19. Include this scripture in your prayers to remind God that you read His bible, and know what to expect from His

promises. Just as, after doing your homework, your parents will reward you with something of a promise once you graduate. God knows what He promised from every verse in the bible, but He just wants you to read it and recite it to Him, to present your knowledge and wisdom, which is VERY important to God. You wouldn't want incapable employees working for you, just as God doesn't want unwise followers to serve His purposes. He wants you as His spiritual companion to serve a purpose as a team.

Of all the overviews from each of God's promises, having the power of love is the most important: love conquers all. Your measurement of love affects your well-being, and how far you will go in life. Showing love, compassion, and understanding to others, will greatly increase your success. Having the right attitude of passion and respect can reduce much stress in your life, verses of having a negative attitude without passion. Satan wants you to be mad, negative, without love and compassion, because these qualities distracts your divine purpose that can cause many mistakes. When you are distracted by stress, negativity, and hate, this cause bad hormones, which affects your mood and concentration to control you to the point of a downward slope. You will need something like great strength of some sort to help you elevate that slope again. Sometimes it's achievable, but with harsh experiences of lessons learned.

## CONCLUSION

God existed as a self-propelled being that no one knows how. As His appearance begins, additional matter that exists in us appeared as well. He claims that “there is no one before or after Me”, and the mystery of Him will be solved. After His existence was completed, God wanted to create other beings that were celestial and terrestrial. The celestial beings were created first, which were the angels, planets, and stars. Once all the celestial beings were in order, God gave them assignments to care and watch over the created terrestrials on Earth. It was very pleasing to God when He created the terrestrials: so that praises, prayers, and burnt sacrifices can ascend to Him. Whichever type of offering or sacrifice that comes from the Earth, whether it’s a sacrificial, praise, prayer, or burnt offerings from candles and incense, this pleases the Lord. He knows that heavenly beings can only offer so much. They can offer prayer and praises, but not sacrifices of flesh and blood.

This is why God created the first terrestrial man and eventually His mortal son Jesus, to enable the value of offering of blood. However, He created man first to offer sacrifices to strengthen man’s love and understanding the principles in sacrificing. By the time Jesus came and died, man knew what agony God went through while His Son was dying on the cross. Without respecting and believing in that, there is no place for man in Heaven. Because God knows that whatever man refuse to believe, it usually involves a level of hatred. Parents, just think for a moment after telling your child that you don’t believe that they can do this or that, what goes through your mind? Think about one of the characteristics of love, which doesn’t condemn or cast down another. When you tell your children negative things, what is your true love towards them? If you really love your child, you would find the smallest positive character in them and use it to tell them: “I believe in you, that you can do anything if it meant to happen for you!” What about telling yourself that you love yourself, but not believe in yourself at the same time? Kind of an odd concept, right? Without believing in yourself, shows a sign of dissatisfaction or discontentment within yourself. Whatever or whomever you love, you would put all of your belief in it or them, if the love is true. God wants you to have the same attitude and belief in Him and His son Jesus, because we are a reflection of Him in likeness. Think about a mirror for a moment and stare at yourself in it. What you see is your reflection that can’t come towards you, but still it’s you! Just as the Earth and its inhabitants are reflections of Heaven, without the Earth being able to be in certain parts of Heaven, but where

it belongs.

There are verses that describe similar things that are in Heaven and on Earth as well, which indicates that the Earth and its elements are a reflection of Heaven: “And the twelve gates were twelve pearls...and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass”(Rev. 21:21); ....(18)“And it was made with cherubims and palm trees, so that a palm tree was between a cherub and a cherub; and every cherub had two faces; ....(22)“The altar of wood was three cubits high, and the length thereof two cubits; and the corners thereof, were of wood: and He said unto me, this IS THE TABLE THAT IS BEFORE THE LORD”(Ezekiel 41:18 & 22). There are reflective events and beings that both appear in Heaven and on Earth. These 2 books of the bible are enough to convince the reflections that are between Heaven and Earth are real. To get a deeper insight of the visions between the 2 prophets, read both books above. If you don't believe the prophets, research on near-death experiences. God had prepared the heavens for all of us, but we must make a choice to where we should go, and we were created in His image and likeness to know good and evil to make those choices.

Evil was created from a result that happened in Heaven between God, Satan, and us. Satan fell because he wanted to take over us and Heaven to overthrow God, but Satan's plans didn't work out. We listened and believed Satan while in Heaven like Adam and Eve did on Earth. However, God gave us another chance by allowing us to incarnate (our fall from grace) for reconciliation. God had also given Adam and Eve a chance, otherwise it seemed that they would have died instantly after their disobedience that changed everything. They were just the reflections of what happened in Heaven before they were created. Before the fruit was bitten, Satan's fall didn't cause mortality. While the battle was won in Heaven over Satan, the battle between Satan, Adam and Eve were lost until God stepped in and cursed Satan. Evil brought in mortality for sacrifice of sins, which is assigned by the Spirit of death that will be swallowed up at the end of time: Isaiah 25:8. There are spirits that control the evil events, from the Spirit of fear(2Tim.1:7), to the Spirit of whoredoms (Hosea 4:12).

Though these spirits are roaming the Earth, Jesus was sent here to help us conquer them by our freewill and power. As mentioned in chapter 3, Jesus gave us the power to cast out evil spirits. He was sent to provide us faith and strength to fight off the Devil and his demons. It's wonderful that Jesus didn't just come to Earth to die for us, but to also bless us by giving a part of His power for anything that comes against us. We may not see miracles happen everyday or as obvious like the ones in the Old Testament, but miracles still occur today in the name of Jesus: take all your troubles to Him, Amen.

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
