## **Excerpt of the Book**

# 1- Egypt Shortly Before Moses

Illustrates how the social life of the Egyptian was in general and the Israelites in particular under the kingship of Pharaoh. It proves that 'Pharaoh' is a proper name of that character, not a title for king.

## 2- Moses' Birth

Talks about the circumstances that surrounded Moses' birth and members of his family, and his adoption by Pharaoh's family.

#### 3- Moses in Sinai Before the Mission

Tells about an episode where Moses travelled to Sinai in his youth and the major incidents he encountered there.

#### 4- The Incident of the Killing of a Man of Pharaoh's People

Goes into some details of an unintentional killing of a man of Pharaoh's people by Moses in support of an Egyptian of Moses' sect.

#### 5- Moses in Midian

Tells about Moses' escape to Midian Town in Sinai, getting married there, and settling there for almost 10 years.

## 6- God's Commissioning of Moses with the Mission

Talks about how and when God commissioned Moses and his brother Aaron to go to and call Pharaoh and his people to believe in God and free the Israelites.

## 7- Moses's Return to Egypt as a Messenger

Narrates the dialogues that took place in the meeting between Moses and Aaron on one side, and Pharaoh, together with Pharaoh's chiefs, on the other side, and Moses presenting them two signs from God, the main of which was Moses' staff turning into a real snake.

## 8- The Day of Competition with God's Signs

Tells of Pharaoh's call for a competition between Moses and the sorcerers of Egypt, to prove that Moses was a mere sorcerer.

## 9- The Exhortation of the Believer among Pharaoh's People

Describes how a believing man among Pharaoh's people exhorts Pharaoh and his people to believe and follow Moses, not kill him.

#### 10- End of Korah the Israelite

Shows how Korah's life ended and the faithful lesson learnt by his people.

#### 11- The Years Preceding the Exodus

Talks about the incidents that happened throughout an interval of almost five years, between Moses' winning the competition against Pharaoh's sorcerers and the Israelites' departing Egypt.

## 12- Length of the Israelites' Stay in Egypt and Their Number

Determines logically and contextually the total length of the stay of the Israelites in Egypt, and their maximum number when departing it.

# 13- Exodus from Egypt

Shows how the Exodus happened, with its surrounding circumstances—mainly the drowning of Pharaoh and his entire army in the Nile River.

## 14- Moses and His People Going to Meet God in Sinai

Details the travelling of the Israelites, led by Moses, to Sinai to meet God in order to send down onto them the religion they were to follow after becoming free, and the main associated events.

# 15- Of Moses' and His People's Life in Sinai

Tells of two main events in the Israelites' life in Sinai in the company of Moses and Aaron.

## 16- Moses' and Aaron's Return to Their Grandfathers' Land

Describes Moses' and Aaron's return, together with those of their people who believed, to the Hejaz region of Arabia, the land God blessed for the Worlds.
