


## Knowledge Box: African Savanna

Savannas are a division of a larger biome of Grasslands. Savannas are found in more tropical climates and regions, and therefore are referred to as Tropical Grasslands.

Savannas are found in Africa, Australia, and India. Out of these, Africa contains the largest Savanna in the world covering about ½ of the entire continent!



The Grassland Biome consists of both Temperate Grasslands and Tropical Grasslands (aka Savannas). While both are dominated by grasses, each has its own unique differences. Temperate Grasslands are characterized by different seasons and a fluctuation of temperatures, whereas Savannas usually have hot and humid climates with more rainfall. Temperate Grasslands typically have no trees, whereas Savannas have some trees and shrubs scattered throughout.
