I had read many times but not coincidentally also the day before about children's behavior being an overt manifestation of the bigger issues lurking underneath. It seemed obvious but I hadn't taken the steps to use this insight as fundamental to a solution either for me or for her. But on that day I was suddenly curious, really curious about her story.
