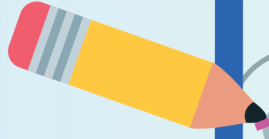


Let's plant seeds together and make letters

and follow the arrow again

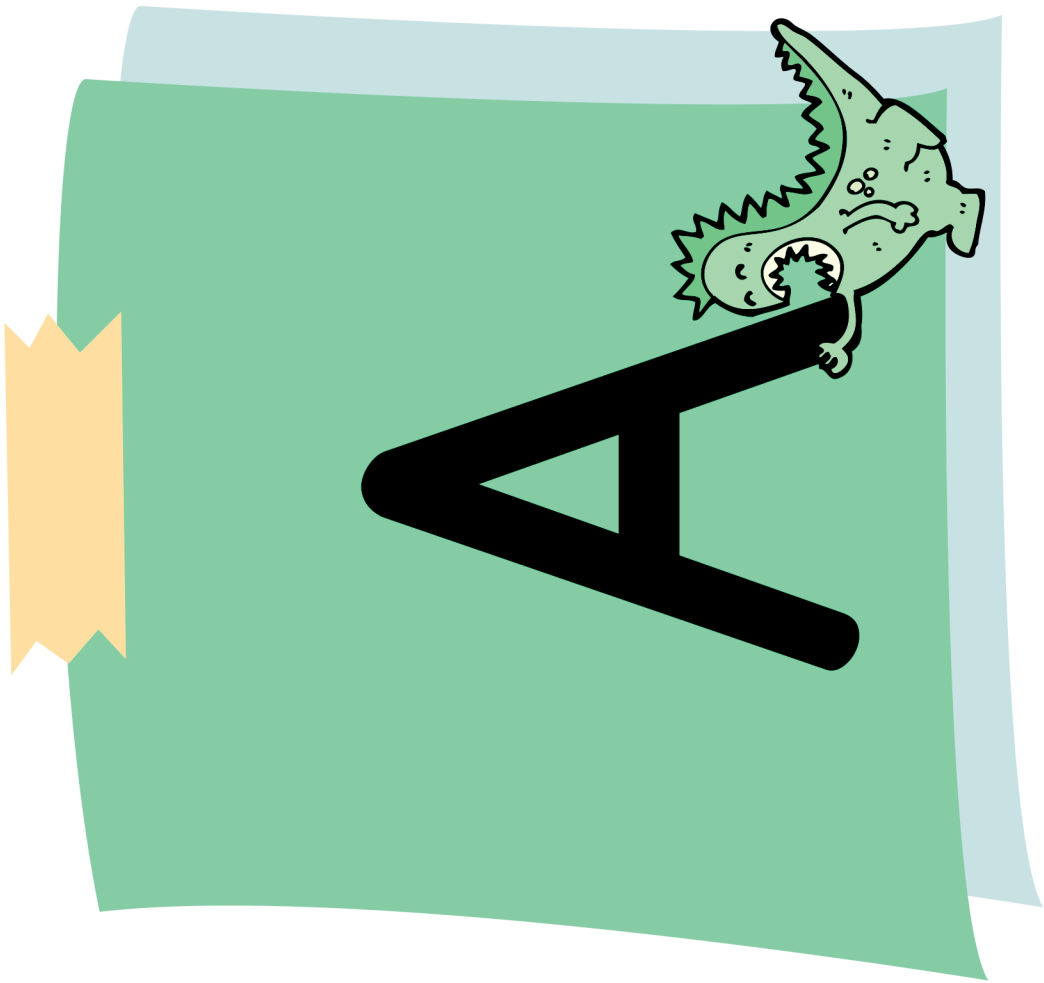
2 **TRACE** the dotted arrow

TOUCH the **BROWN** line,


where seeds are planted

third stroke, follow that one too. It may
touch the **GREEN** line in the middle.


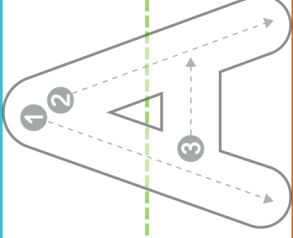
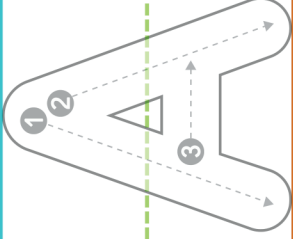
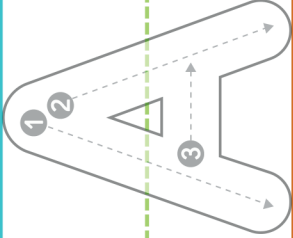
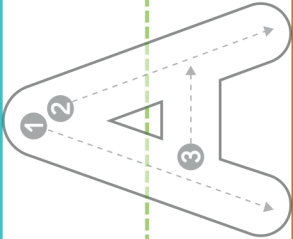





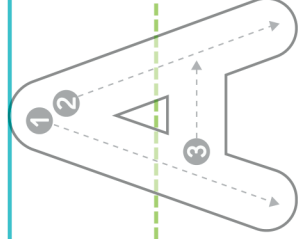
