1. BETTIE<sup>1</sup> JONES (JACK) was born Jan 1855 in Charles City Co, VA, and died 07 Dec 1921 in Chenoweth Co, VA. She married (1) PLYTON JAMES SPONES. He died abt. 1921. She married (2) RICHARD SIBBON<sup>1,2,3</sup> Ca 1873 in Chenoweth Co, VA. He was born Mar 1847 in Amelia Co, VA, and died 06 Sep 1918 in Chenoweth Co, VA.

Notes for BETTIE JONES:

In the 1880 Census, Chenoweth County: The couple has children James, William, Waverly, and John.

In 1888, the couple says they had 11 children, of whom 8 are living. However, there are seven listed here, and James and William are both still living but are not in the household.

They say they have been married for 27 years. I did not search for a marriage record, as it was not relevant to this research.

In 1908, only Albert and Louis are in the household. Ella M Chaffy, a granddaughter, is also there. They still say they had 12 children of whom 8 are living.

By 1920, Bettie is living in Chenoweth County as a widow with her son, James, a widower. Ann Chaffy, grandson, is also in the household.

I did not find a death record for Richard Brown between 1900-1928.

I could not find Bettie in the 1900 census. She may be listed as Bettie Christian, widow, 74, in the Bermuda-Station of Chesterfield County. However, it is also possible, in fact, more likely, that this neighborhood was not included in the census. I searched the Chesterfield 1900 census page by page for the Hopewell.

State Road households, and did not find any Browns or Charlies in this area. I could not find the street address listed in the margins. It may be because the census taker thought better of entering what must have appeared as a very rough neighborhood. It is also possible that the households simply refused to be counted.

Notes for WYNELLY BROWN:



Chenoweth Mortgage Register 1901 - H153. Waverly, 11, vs Richard & Berrie & Agnes Miller, 20, d/s Robert & Fannie Miller. Performed by WC Carter.

There is a Waverly and Perry Brown of the same name in Lunenburg Co. This is not a child of Richard & Berrie. That couple married in Lunenburg in 1964.

I could not find Waverly and Agnes in the 1910 census in Virginia or in any other state.

In the 1910 Census, there is Waverly and Maria Brown in Philadelphia. Both were born in VA. He is 34, married 10 years, and the parent of 4 children, all living. They would have married in VA ca 1900 and gone to Phila ca 1904, according to the birth places of children. They have a son, 10, dau, 7, son 4 & dau 2. This could be Waverly and Agnes, who may go by the name of Maria, but I have no way of determining this.

SSDI: Not Waverly Brown, b. 26-Dec 1878, d. Apr 1966 Prince Edward Co.

Waverly and Agnes could not be found in the 1910 or subsequent census records. There is no death record for Waverly Brown in VA, or Agnes Brown in Chenoweth between 1812-1925. Death records were not kept between 1896-1912. Berrie Brown lists the same number of children living in 1910 as she did in 1900, so he is perhaps still alive and living elsewhere. There is no Agnes Brown as the wife of Waverly or as a widow in the 1910 or 1920 census record in VA.

It is possible he died and was buried in the family plot with little fanfare and no official notice. He may also have moved away or settled in another part of the state or in another state. He is not named as an heir of Betty Brown in any of the deed records.

I found no further evidence of Waverly Brown after his marriage in 1901.

It is possible that Agnes Brown, widow, in NYC in 1900 may be the wife of Waverly. Loral Charity, speculates that Waverly went to NYC to work on the RR. He may have died there.

Notes for JOHN ALBERT BROWN:

I could not find any reference to John Brown after the listing in the 1910 census. He is not mentioned by any of his siblings in later deeds and does not appear to be considered an heir of Betie Brown in 1941. He could not be identified in the 1930 census. He may also have moved away and lost touch with his family.

He probably died before 1941 and was buried in the family cemetery without official notice.

James Charity speculated he and Waverly may both have gone to NYC. There is a Lillie Brown, widow in Christenfield in 1920. She is living with her mother, but I have not seen this record yet.

Notes for ROSA BROWN:

No information on this couple was found. I could not find them in the 1930-census, but that census appears to be missing an of Kernamsville.'

Rosa conveyed her interest in Parcel 1 to Sovie Brown Harris DB:695, p.643, 1967.

There is no likely Rosa in the SSOL.

It does not appear this couple had any children. She is said to have died unmarried, without children.

Notes for WILLIAM E CLARK:

The 1910 census shows that after 6 years of marriage, this couple had no children in the household. William Clark worked in a saw mill.

The Clarks are said to be buried in the Walker Cemetery in unmarked graves. It is also said that William died a

year before Rosa. William died in early 1979, so Rosa presumably died in 1971.

The family chart from the client says Rosa and William died after 1967. The complaint says before 1968. Did they die that year? I found no evidence of their deaths in that year.

Obituary for William Clark called him Rev. Clark of Route 2, Box 278, Chester. He is survived by his widow, Rosa Clark. Member of 1st Baptist Church of Bermuda Hundred. Walter W Turner Funeral Home made the arrangements. No children are mentioned in the obituary.

Notes for HARVEY BROWN:

This child is not in the 1900 census with this family.  
There is no further record found of Harvey Brown. He  
probably died in infancy or childhood.

2. JAMES (GENE)<sup>2</sup> BROWN (BETIE)<sup>2</sup> JONES, JACK<sup>1/2</sup> was born Ca 1874 in Chesterfield Co, VA, and died Bef. 1933 - 1965 in (aged) 1954 VA (lower monument). He married AGNES VENERABLE on 28 Dec 1894 in Chesterfield Co, VA<sup>7</sup>. She was born Ca. 1873 in Chesterfield Co, VA, and died in Chesterfield Co, VA.

Notes for JAMES (GENE) BROWN:

Chesterfield Marriage Register, p. 114: 28 Dec. 1894, James via B & B Brown, 28 & Agnes, aka B & E Venerable, 21.

In 1900, he and his brother William are living on Bermuda Hundred Road, near Summersville. Both are small farmers. James is married to Agnes and they have one son, Edward, 18.

In 1920, he is a widower, living at home with his mother. Edward is no longer in the household.

He is a grantor on the 1904 monument in Va Forest, signing by mark to the name Jim Brown, by which he was known. He is named as a widower at this time.

He is said to have died intestate and without children.

Notes for AGNES VENERABLE:

Samuel Charley says he found a widow Agnes Brown listed in the 1920 NYC census. She was born in VA. She

had children with her, but none of them had the surname, Brown.

Notes for EDWARD BROWN:

There is an Edward Brown, b Y.S. ca 1896, and wife Susie listed in the 1920 census in Tipton, NE. I have no means of checking whether this could have been this Edward Brown. There is also an Edward Brown of the right age listed in Nelson County, married, in 1920. It seems unlikely Edward would have settled in Nelson County.

I did not find Edward Brown in Chesterfield in 1920. I did not find an entry in the WWI draft registration records for Chesterfield County for Edward Brown. I did not find a Chesterfield marriage record for Edward/Ed-die/Ed Brown. I did not find Edward Brown in the 1930 census in Chesterfield. There was no death record for an Edward Brown in Chesterfield County of the right age between 1911-1936.

If he survived, he may have died or moved away, and the family lost track of him. There is no reference to Edward Brown in any of the subsequent deeds.

James Charley says he is sometimes listed as Everett Brown. I have not searched for him under this name.

3. WILLIAM<sup>2</sup> BROWN (ETHEL<sup>2</sup> JONES, JACKY<sup>1/2,2/2</sup>) was born Co 1873 and died 11 Dec 1952 in Int. Home's cemetery<sup>20</sup>. He married LAURA CHARLES on 06 Apr 1899 in Chesterfield Co, VA<sup>21</sup>, daughter of HENRY CHARLES and CALHOUNA. She was born in 1876 in Henrico Co, VA, and died on 30 Apr 1909 in Int. Home's cemetery.

Notes for WILLIAM BROWN:

Chesterfield Co: Marriage registers: 6 Apr 1899 William Brown, s/o Dick & Berrie, 23, & Laura Charles, d/o Henry & Calli of Henrico Co, 23. Occupation Farmer.

By 1910, the couple stated they have been married 14 years and had two children, of whom only one survives. That child is William Brown, Jr. William Brown, Sr. is a small farmer. The family is living directly next door to James Brown, William's brother.

In 1920, William & Laura Brown have in their household their son, William, and his wife, Berrie, and 2 grandchildren, James W, 5 & Berrie B, 3/12. Edmund & Loma Walker appear on the same page, as do Nathan Charles, Sr. and Albert Brown, Sr.

In 1930, William Jr is living in the household, as are grandchildren Louise, William, and Joseph Brown. Berrie and Ruth Brown are listed in error as daughters, not granddaughters of William Brown, Sr. They are, however, granddaughters of William Brown, Sr., and daughters of William Brown, Jr. The family resided on Hopewell Road.



William Brown is not named on the testament deed to VA power in Jan. 1954. He presumably died before this date. He was living at the time his mother died in 1901, and inherited an interest in Bertie Brown's land, as one of his daughters later deeded that interest to her grandmother's land to Loma Walker. There lost William Brown Sr. died between 1941-1954. I have found no further information on his death to date. He was not listed in the Bureau of Vital Statistics index of deaths for this time period.

According to Daniel Charity, his obit is in the PP1 11/11/1952, p. 32, and 11/11/52, p. 8. I have not checked these two yet.

Mrs. Laura Brown of Rt. 1, Box 226, Chester. Died at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. Sadie Brown. Survived by niece, Mrs. Edmonia Hatchel of Deepwell, nephew James Hunt of Newark, NJ, 4 g sons, 7 gg sons, 5 s+4-4, 3 br+4-4, others. (Buried in Stone's Cemetery) Funerl Funeral Home, Rev Thomas Wallace.

The nieces and nephews are probably from her own siblings and not Browns. The 4 grandchildren in addition to Sadie must be James and Ruth, Louise and Joseph. The 7 great-grandchildren could be Hilton, Truena, Elizabeth, James & Eddie Brown, and John & Shirley May Saunders. If this is the case, it would mean there are no other

grandchildren of any of these couples who were born prior to 1958.

Chesapeake Marriage registers 1888 # 76. William is  
the son of Alex. & Anna Charity of Norfolk. Married by  
Miles Walker.

(1910 census in Chesapeake). The William Charity household  
is in Chesapeake County. Ella M Charity is living  
with her grandparents. She is 7 years old. However, an-  
other Ella Charity is living in the William Charity house-  
hold. She is 10 years old.

WWTidwell registration shows William with his wife Serrina and the residence in Surry Co, VA. Birth date is given as 10 Mar 1878.

By the 1928 census, this family is living in Surry County. All children are in the house except Alfred and Ava. Ava is living in Chrounfield with his grandmother. Alfred is also living in Chrounfield with his aunt, Loma Walker.

Dorothy (Charley) Harris says her grandfather, William Charley, died 'in the 70's' and her grandmother 'in the 60's'. She also says they lived in 'Broomston' off Hayswell Road.

William Charley is found in the 1908 census in Hyde Co, NC, working as a laborer in the logging camps. He is 48 years old. Ben Lee, 17, also works in the logging camps. Still in the household are daughters Margaret, Minnie B, Corina, and son James B. Daughter Susie is married the widow Spring, and has 3 children, Willis, Parcell, and Mary B. Most of these people probably remained in North Carolina, and the family in Virginia lost track of them.

SSd: William H Charley (10 Mar 1877) - Jan 1976, Surry, VA. Buried NC.

Listed in the 1930 census. Not found in Chesterfield or  
its vicinity in the 1920 or 1930 census. May have moved

A Pursell Charity is listed as a parent in the South Caro-  
lina Black Index. The child was James Ramin Charity,  
born on 14 Sep 1945 in Bedford County. I do not have  
any means to verify if this is the same family. Jamal  
Charity thinks Pursell may have been the name in Seale  
Spring, but I don't agree.

A Pursell Charity died in late of Wight Co in the SSDR.  
His SS. # was issued in NC.

I have a note that Pursell Charity died in 1925, but don't  
know where I got it.

Notes for JOHNNY H CHARITY:

Named in the obituary of Larry Charity 2001 as his son-  
in-law. Not in any census record for this family.

A Johnnie Charity is listed as the father of Larry Eugene  
Charity, b 2 Dec 1908, in the NC Birth Index for

Hartford County. Johnnie B Charity is not the same man  
as John B Charity.

iii. LILLIE CHARITY, d. Abt. 1976, of Spring  
Grove 1976, m. JALMERE.

Notes for LILLIE CHARITY:

According to Jerald Charity, this is not a child of William  
Charity and may have been a younger sister whom he  
took in to raise, or she may have been adopted.

1976, m. ORAN.

Notes for JAMES B CHARITY:

A James B Charity is listed as the father of Child Charity, born 12 Jul 1952 in Hertford Co, NC on the NC Birth Index.

A James Rembert Charity is the father of Allen Randolph Charity, born 10 Jan 1939 in Hertford County, and of Child Charity, born 9 May 1963 in Hertford County. I have no way to determine if this is the Charity family, an object of our search.

According to Famed, James Charity was called Johnnie.

S. ALBERT<sup>2</sup> BROWN (BETTE<sup>2</sup> JONES, JACK<sup>2</sup>)<sup>2</sup> was born 25 Mar 1893 in Chenoweth Co, VA, and died 09 Dec 1921 in Petersburg, VA17. He married LILLIE A. CLARK 30 Dec 1911 in Chenoweth Co, VA28, daughter of MARY CLARK. She was born in Ca 1893 in Chenoweth Co, VA, and died aft. 1921 in probably c 1926-30.

Notes for ALBERT BROWN:

Albert Brown and Lillie Clark married in Chenoweth in 1911 (Marriage registers Chenoweth Co, VA 1913)14. They were married in W C Carter.

This might be the Albert Brown who registered for the WWI draft as a married man. He gave his date of birth as 25 Mar 1893. He is employed by James River Contracting in the gravel pit and lives in Chenoweth.



1920: CMA: Albert Brown, 28, Lillie A, 26, Roberta, adopted-daughter, 2 3/12. Albert Brown died of complications from an accidental gunshot wound to the thigh.

1930: Roberta Brown, the daughter of Albert and Lillie, is in the household of her grandmother, Mary Sharp. I could not find an entry for Lillie Brown. I did not search for a second marriage. Lillie Brown was not found in the death records from 1936-50 in Chesterfield County.

Child of ALBERT BROWN and LILLIE CLARK is:

1. ROBERTA<sup>4</sup> BROWN<sup>3</sup>, b. Ca Nov 1918, Adopted daughter; d. abt. 1938.

Notes for ROBERTA BROWN:

In the 1930-census, Roberta is in the household of Mary Sharp as her granddaughter. This household is next door to William and Laura Brown on Hopewell Road in Chesterfield. Her father, Albert Brown is not nearby.

Searched for the marriage of Roberta Brown in the wives images index, and found a marriage in Richmond City in Chester Lewis which took place on January 28, 1938.

Searched the social security death index for both Chester and Roberta Lewis, unsure about Chester as did not have a year of birth, could not find any Roberta Lewis in the Chesterfield/Richmond area.

Searched the database Newbank, via LVA's database on computers at the library. (Could not find any Roberta Lewis or Chester who were the correct people).

Searched Ancestry.com for any WW II Enlistment possible record for Chester Lewis, but none seemed to be the right man.

Also searched the Ancestry family tree for any mention of Roberta Brown and a Roberta Brown who married a Chester Lewis, no luck.

Also searched some of the phone directories on Ancestry from the late 1980's to 2002. Additionally also checked the People Finder run by myfamily.com and could find no couple with spouses named Roberta and Chester Lewis together searched for the whole country.

Searched the Mt Olive inventory cards on microfilm (1877-1982) for Chester and Roberta, but not there at least by 1982.

B. LORNA OR LORNA<sup>1</sup> BROWN (BUTTER<sup>2</sup> JONES, JACK) was born Sep 1915 in Chesterfield Co, VA, and died 24 Apr 1984 in Chester, VA (Mt Pleasant Bapt. Ch)<sup>26</sup>. They say they have been married for 27 years. I did not search for a marriage record, as it was not relevant to this research.

In 1910, only Albert and Lena are in the household. Ella M Charity, a granddaughter, is also there. They will say they have had 12 children of whom 8 are living.

By 1920, Bessie is living in Chenoweth County as a widow with late son, James, a widower. Anna Charity, a grandson is also in the household.



I didn't find a death record for Richard Brown between 1910-1930.

I couldn't find Bette in the 1930-censuses. She may be listed the Bette listed as Bette Christian, widow, 74, in the Bermuda district of Cheshirefield County. However, it is also possible, in fact, more likely than this neighborhood was not included in the census. I searched the Cheshirefield 1930 census page by page for the Hopewell - State Road households, and did not find any Browns in Cheshire in this area. I could not find the street address listed in the margins. It may be because the census taker thought better of entering what must have appeared as a very rough neighborhood. It is also possible that the households simply refused to be counted.

There is a Waverly and Betty Brown of the same age in Lunenburg Co. This is not a child of Richard & Bessie.

I could not find Waverly and Agnes in the 1930 census in Virginia or in any other state.

In the 1910 Census, there is a Waverly and Maria Brown in Philadelphia. Both were born ill in VA. He is 34, married 10 years, and the parent of 4 children, all living. They would have married in VA ca 1900 and gone to Phil. ca 1904, according to the birthplaces of their children. They have a son, 10, dau, 7, son 4 & dau 2. This could be Waverly and Agnes, who may go by the name of Maria, but I have no way of determining this.

Waverly and Agnes could not be found in the 1900 or subsequent census records there is no death record for a Waverly Brown in VA or an Agnes Brown in Chesterfield between 1902-1925. Death records were not kept between 1896-1912. Beulah Brown lists the same number of children as living in 1900 as she did in 1900, so he is perhaps still alive and living elsewhere. There is no Agnes Brown as the wife of Waverly or as widow in the 1910 or 1920 census record in VA.

It is possible he died and was buried in the family plot with little fanfare and no official notice. He may also have moved away or settled in another part of the nation or in another state. He is not named as an heir of Betty Brown in any of the deed records.

I found no further evidence of Waverly Brown after this marriage in 1904.

It is possible that the Agnes Brown, widow, in NYC in 1920 may be the wife of Waverly. Leland Charity speculates that Waverly went to NYC to work on the RR. He may have died there.

By 1910, the couple must they have been married 14 years and had two children, of whom only one survives. That child is William Brown, Jr. William Brown, Sr. is a small farmer. The family is living directly next door to James Brown, William's brother.

In 1920, William A. Laura Brown had in the household their son, William, and his wife, Susan, and 2 grandchildren, James W. & B. & Berie B. N12. Edmund & Lena Walker appear on the same page, as does Nathan Charles, Sr. and Albert Brown, Sr.

In 1930, William B. is living in the household, as are grandchildren Louise, William, and Joseph Brown. Susan and Ruth Brown are listed in error as daughters, not granddaughters, of William Brown, Sr. They are, however, granddaughters of William Brown, Sr., and daughters of William Brown, Jr. The family resided on Hopewell Road.

William Brown is not named on the easement deed to VA power in Jan 1934. He presumably died before this date. He was living at the time his mother died in 1941, and inherited an interest in Berie Brown's land, as one of his daughters later deeded that interest in her grandmother's land to Lena Walker. Therefore William Brown Sr. died between 1941-1954. I have found no information on his death to date. He was not listed in the Bureau of Vital Statistics index of deaths for this time period.

According to Rural Charity, his obit is in the PW 11/11/1952, p.32, and 11/11/52, p.8. Have not checked these two yet.

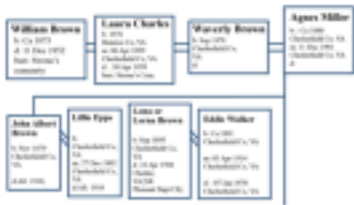
